CONVERGING took part in the [HaDEA Showcase Event 2026](#), a flagship European gathering organised by the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA), highlighting high-impact projects funded by the European Union.

The event brought together policymakers, research organisations, industry leaders and innovators to demonstrate how EU-funded initiatives are strengthening Europe's competitiveness, sustainability and digital and health ecosystems. With 500 in-person participants and 150 online attendees, the showcase featured 26 high-level speakers and 14 project stands. Discussions focused on translating research results into real-world impact, improving regulatory frameworks and scaling up innovation across value chains.
