## 6th General Assembly of the CONVERGING Project successfully held

The consortium of the CONVERGING Project successfully convened for its 6th General Assembly, bringing together partners to review progress, align on next steps, and strengthen collaboration as the project advances toward its final phase.

A key focus of the Assembly was the evaluation framework. 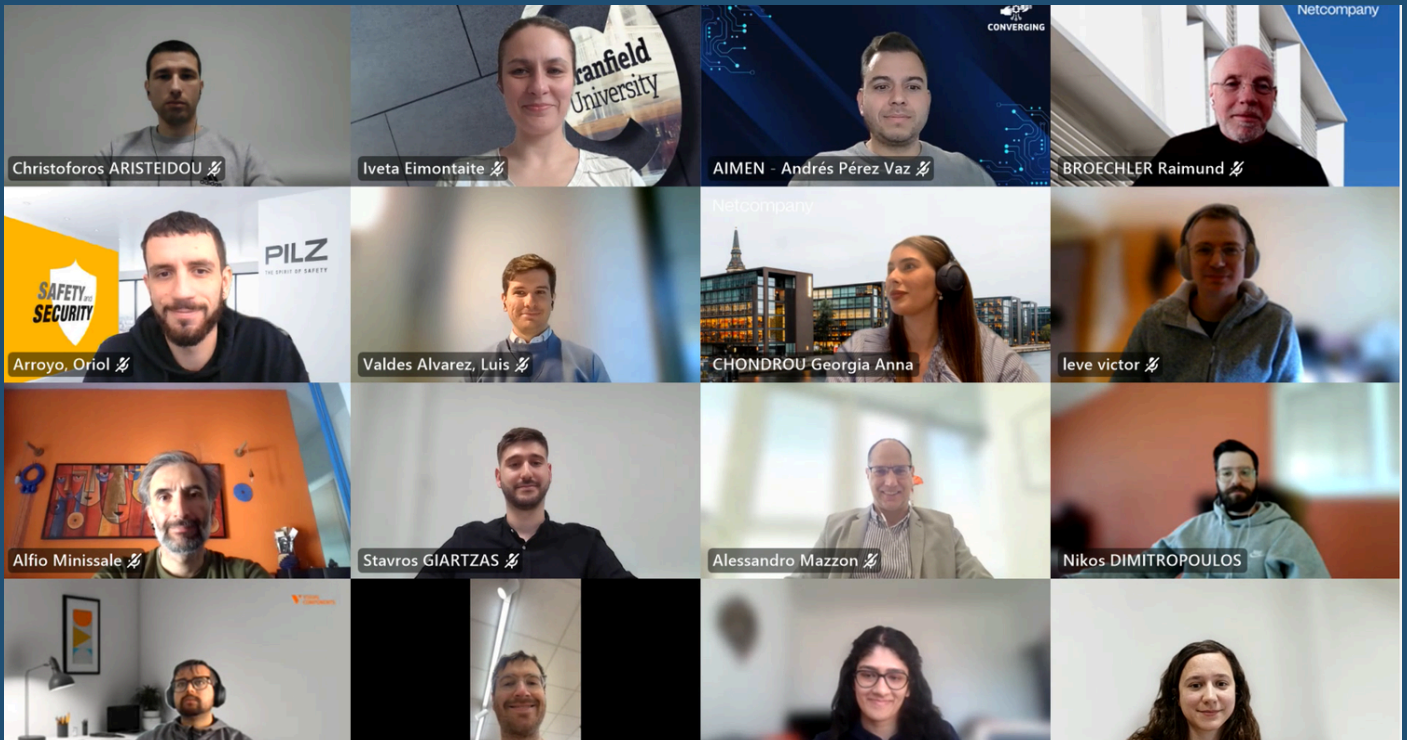
